Berkeley Recognizes Its Future Leaders

Berkeley Township honored some of its best and brightest young people earlier this summer, thanks to the annual Fire Prevention Poster Contest and the D.A.R.E. Program.

Each year, a Fire Prevention Poster Contest is held, challenging Berkeley students to create posters based around a specific theme, all with the intention of helping educate kids about good fire prevention practices. This year's theme was, "Fire Won't Wait. Plan Your Escape." The goal was to get students to recognize the importance of having a plan to escape in the case of a fire.

"The winners of the contest did an excellent job depicting their planned escape route to safety. I commend all participants," Council President John Bacchione said.

Essentials for having a good escape plan include identifying all possible escape routes, including all doors, windows, and stairways. Households should also assign specific responsibilities to family members when the fire alarm goes off. For example, this could include one person taking care of pets, another checking the rooms to make sure everyone is out, and so on.

Also, ensure you have a place at a safe distance from the house where everyone will gather, and periodically go over or practice your plan.

Finally, never forget the importance of technology.

"Having a working smoke and carbon monoxide detector in your home will alert residents to get out safely before it's too late," Mayor Carmen Amato said. This means checking the batteries and changing them as needed, and periodically testing the detectors.

Also honored this summer were the town's 2023 D.A.R.E. Program Role Models.

Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) is a nationwide program that was established in 1983 and aims to educate young people on the dangers of drug use, and empower them with the necessary tools and strategies to resist peer pressure, violence, and other risky behaviors. The K-12 program uses a collaborative approach that involves the school, law enforcement community, and parents. D.A.R.E. instructors lead classroom sessions, role-playing exercises, and other interactive activities.



MORE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF ON THE WAY – THIS FALL!

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for signing petitions, calling state legislators and the Governor's office in support of our efforts for more property tax relief. If you recall, a few short years ago, the State of New Jersey was considering cutting the Senior Freeze and Homestead Benefit property tax relief programs. What a difference a few years make.


Because of our combined efforts, the State of New Jersey - with bipartisan support - created a NEW Property Tax Relief program called the ANCHOR Program. (Affordable New Jersey Communities for Homeowners and Renters). The ANCHOR Program replaced the Homestead Property Tax Credit program. Under the ANCHOR Program, eligible homeowners received a check or direct deposit from the state treasury this past May, depending on your income levels. Homeowners who made \$150,000 or less in 2019, received \$1,500. Homeowners who made between \$150,001 and \$250,000, received \$1,000. If you did not receive you ANCHOR payment, call the ANCHOR HOTLINE at: 1-888-238-1233.

Recently, the State of New Jersey - with bipartisan support - created a new property tax relief program called STAY-NJ. The STAY-NJ Program will provide seniors aged 65 and older, a 50% property tax reduction for senior homeowners earning \$500,000 or less, capped at \$6,500. This direct property tax relief program is slated to begin in January 2026.

As part of the STAY-NJ legislation, included in the July 1st, 2023, to June 30th, 2024, State Budget, the ANCHOR Program will INCREASE for homeowners, who are 65 or older, by \$250. This means senior homeowners who made \$150,000 or less will receive \$1,750 and senior homeowners who made \$150,001 up to \$250,000, will receive \$1,250. Our Berkeley Township Council, led by Council President John Bacchione, and I, unanimously supported and approved a resolution in support of the STAY-NJ Program.

Initially, those who qualified for the 2019 ANCHOR payment would receive notice about the 2020 ANCHOR payment in May of 2024. THE GOOD NEWS is the Treasury has started notifying those who previously received the 2019 ANCHOR payment with information about their 2020 ANCHOR payment.

An "ANCHOR Benefit Confirmation Letter" was mailed mid August, with information about the 2020 ANCHOR payment. The treasury anticipates the 2020 ANCHOR payment will arrive via check or direct deposit in October this year.



The State is becoming unaffordable for our seniors on fixed incomes. The STAY-NJ program, when implemented, will provide additional and welcome property tax relief. I want to thank 9th District Assemblyman Brian Rumpf, a member of the state Assembly Budget Committee, who supported the program. As Mayor, the Township Council and I will continue to keep a watchful eye on the State to make sure they uphold their commitment to fund these vital property tax relief programs for our residents.

NO MUNICIPAL TAX INCREASE IN 2023 BUDGET

The 2023 municipal budget was unanimously approved by the Township in July. As I stated in the last issue, there is NO MUNICIPAL TAX INCREASE for 2023! The municipal budget will keep our tax rate the same as last year, at \$0.705 per \$100 of assessed valuation. This is extremely good news for our taxpayers. With the sharp increase due to inflation and the unique set of challenges due to the pandemic, this was no easy task to accomplish. Property owners should have received your final tax bill in late July or early August. If you did not receive your final tax bill, please contact the Tax Collector at (732) 244-7400 ext.1240.

Please keep in mind that the municipal portion, including our open space tax, is a little over 30% of the total bill. This is the ONLY portion of your tax bill under the direct control of the Mayor and Council. The remaining, nearly 70% of your bill, which includes county government, county library, county health, county open-space and the school district taxes, the Township has zero control over.

Despite these challenges, Berkeley Township continues to have the 2nd lowest OVERALL property taxes in all of OCEAN COUNTY and the 31st lowest OVERALL property taxes out of 564 municipalities in New Jersey. Thank you to the members of the Township Council, especially Council President John Bacchione, who chairs our Finance Committee, for working with me to keep the costs of government down. The average Berkeley Township homeowner will continue to pay less than half of the statewide average property tax bill. That is a significant accomplishment we all can be proud of. As 2023 progresses, the Township Council and I will continue to work hard to keep Berkeley Township the best town to live, work, raise a family and retire.

Grants Will Help Recruit New Firefighters, Make Town More Energy Efficient

Grant money provided by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and the U.S. Department of Energy will help make Berkeley a little safer and a little greener.

The Bayville Fire Company was awarded \$40,000 from the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant program, run by DHS and FEMA. The money will go towards technology to help the company with recruitment.

The volunteer Bayville Fire Company responds to emergencies throughout the township, and also provides support to surrounding communities. This includes local highways, Island Beach State Park, and the Ocean County Airport aka Miller Air Park. All of its roughly 50 active members are volunteers.

Members come and go, however, so efforts to bring in new recruits never cease.

Using grant funds, the company will purchase an LED sign as part of its outreach campaign. Turnout gear sized to fit all new recruits will also be purchased in order to make the transition into service easier for new volunteers.

"We are excited to modernize our department and recruit and train the next generation of firefighters, who will carry the tradition of quality community fire response marked by bravery and commitment to public safety," said Bayville Fire Company Chief John McKay.

Retirements and the lingering effects of Covid-19 shutdowns have caused a drop in membership, and the town's older population can make recruiting new members difficult. The LED sign will be set at the front of the company's headquarters at 645 Atlantic City Blvd. (Route 9), and will invite people from the community to join. The new turnout gear will mean the people who do sign up will be well-outfitted from day one.

"Berkeley Township is home to over 43,000 people," said Mayor Carmen Amato. "Due to our proximity to the Jersey Shore, our region sees that population double during the summer months. It is imperative that we take all steps to keep our fire departments fully staffed in order to provide adequate protection to the residents of Berkeley Township and the surrounding communities."

Meanwhile, the township will be receiving just over \$76,000 from the Department of Energy as part of its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program. Berkeley was one of just 77 towns in New Jersey to receive this funding. The money comes as part of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021.

How the funds will be used has not yet been determined. Plans call for the money to be budgeted in 2024.

Under the program, the funds can be used for energy efficient equipment rebates, public education campaigns to improve recycling and energy consumption, climate-friendly incentive programs, and more. The goal is to develop better energy efficiency and conservation strategies. These can range from better bike paths and pedestrian-friendly infrastructure to switching to electric vehicles, installing solar and wind infrastructure on government buildings, and more.

"Berkeley is home to some of the most beautiful natural resources in New Jersey, from our beaches to our forests and nearby state parks," said Council President John Bacchione. "These funds are an investment by DOE in our township's future, and this can ensure our assets are running efficiently—from our lands, our infrastructure, to our buildings, making sure we utilize the latest technology to lower costs and reduce harmful impacts."

Anchor Property Tax Rebate Checks Should Be Arriving Soon

Homeowners in Berkeley may soon receive a welcome envelope in the mail, if they haven't already: rebate checks from the state's ANCHOR program, the successor to the Homestead Rebate program.

This year, \$2 billion was set aside in the state budget to fund the program. Under the plan, ANCHOR rebates of up to \$1,500 are sent to households making less than \$250,000 a year, and to renters making less than \$150,000 a year. Some 1.7 million residents in all will receive the rebates, including many in Berkeley Township. Checks are expected to arrive by November 1, and will be between \$450 and \$1,500.

If you received a rebate last year, there is no need to file for one this year. You will automatically be enrolled.

Ocean County Commissioner Joseph H. Vicari said homeowners should keep an eye on their mailboxes in the weeks ahead.

"Letters now being sent confirm that the homeowner or renter is eligible and he or she does not need to take any further action to receive the state money this year," Vicari said.

About 2 million qualifying residents who did not receive a rebate last year will instead get applications in the mail.

The Division of Taxation started mailing the letters August 15. It is likely that most Berkeley residents will have received the letter or application as this story goes to press.

If you have not received a confirmation letter or application by the time you read this, contact the Ocean County Office of Senior Services at 732-929-2091.

If you need to change information on your existing application, the filing deadline is September 30. New applicants may file until Friday, December 29.

Payments are issued on a rolling basis, roughly 90 days after applying.

"These grants are especially important to our seniors living on fixed incomes," Vicari said. "Seniors will receive an additional \$250 this year in an effort to combat rising costs for food, housing and medicine."





Gov. Phil Murphy told WHYY News the program "drops your property tax levels back a decade or more."

Michael Hayes, assistant public policy professor at Rutgers University-Camden, said it's vital to get the word out about the program, because often, homeowners don't even know that programs like this exist.

"Sometimes these types of government programs are not fully utilized because people are not aware of them or in some cases there's high administrative burdens for people to complete the application to get their eligible benefit," he told WHYY.

Anchor is the replacement for the Homestead Benefit. Homeowners with incomes up to \$150,000 are eligible to receive \$1,500, and those earning up to \$250,000 can receive \$1,000. Renters earning up to \$150,000 are eligible to receive \$450 to help offset rent hikes.

"Over the last two years we have committed over \$6 billion in direct property tax relief, tackling one of the single greatest and longest standing affordability challenges our state faces," Murphy said of this year's funding. "We are accomplishing all of this in a fiscally responsible way. This budget continues to fully deliver on our commitments to our pension payments and school funding, while also maintaining a healthy surplus."

How to Overcome Mobility Issues in Your Senior Years

Retirement communities like Holiday City and Silver Ridge Park are popular in part because they are safe and beautiful places to take a stroll, with winding sidewalks, green lawns, and miles to explore.

But not every senior citizen is able to take full advantage of the walkable neighborhoods in Berkeley, due to chronic mobility issues, and this can have a dramatic effect on someone's life.

"As people are living longer, being able to maintain independence in older age becomes more important," said Alan Castel, Ph.D., professor of psychology at the University of California.

This is not an uncommon problem. Decreased mobility among the elderly is a growing problem, with upwards of 35 percent of those over the age of 70 having mobility limitations, according to a 2020 study.

Decreased mobility carries a range of serious risks and potential dangers for older individuals. From reduced independence and decreased social interactions to higher risk of falls, there are common challenges that can arise from limited physical movement.

The most common risk is slips and falls, which in serious cases can lead to severe injuries, fractures and head trauma.

According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), "Falls and motor vehicle crashes, which are related to mobility, are leading causes of injury and injury death in adults 65 and over."

Additionally, seniors with mobility challenges may experience an increased risk of developing chronic diseases, such as heart disease, diabetes, or depression.

"When older adults stop driving or fall," the CDC writes, "they often experience reductions in their health, social interactions, and the ability to get around."



Seniors with mobility issues also struggle to prepare meals, and may skip meals altogether to avoid the difficulty. This can lead to malnourishment, which increases the likelihood of accidents. The same holds true for managing and taking necessary medications.

Just as concerning, mobility problems can make it difficult for retirees to stay active and to socialize, leading to social isolation. This may lead to depression, anxiety, and other mental health issues.

Fortunately, there are proactive steps that older Americans and their families can take to better manage mobility issues. For example,

regular exercise is a key component of maintaining mobility. Participating in activities like walking, swimming, or yoga can help improve range of motion and reduce the risk of injury, though be careful to only do so within one's ability. If you have issues moving around, it's best to consult with your doctor and/or a physical rehab specialist before choosing an exercise plan. This can help prevent further injuries.

"Exercising regularly is great for both the body and mind, but understanding how to prevent injury, particularly for older people, is essential," said Helen Holland, an adult social care expert in the UK.

Using common mobility aids can help someone get around easier, ensuring they are better able to socialize, run errands, and generally live life. These include canes, walkers, and wheelchairs, all of which can help improve safety and reduce the risk of falls. Even something as simple as supportive shoes can be helpful. A good fit with proper arch support can go a long way towards improving balance.


