NJ Natural Gas Seeks Major Rate Hike

New Jersey Natural Gas has again asked the state to approve a rate hike, one that, if approved, would boost bills by up to 24 percent.

Lawmakers are calling for the NJ Board of Public Utilities (BPU) to reject the proposal.

New Jersey Natural Gas wants to increase overall billings by \$222.6 million. According to the company, the goal is to recoup \$850 million invested in infrastructure improvements since 2021.

If approved, the average monthly bill for a homeowner would increase from \$122.84 to \$151.85, an increase of \$29, or 23.6 percent.

The rate hike is not guaranteed. It must be approved by the BPU. The review process could take up to a year.

The request is one of a series of hikes the utility has requested over the last 10 years, including a proposed 25 percent increase in 2021 (approved in 2022), along with requests of 24 percent in 2015 and 19 percent in 2018. The first two increases were reduced before they were approved by the BPU, while 2021-2022's request was approved, increasing costs to the average homeowner by \$256 a year.

Lawmakers wasted no time blasting the latest proposal. State Senator Carmen Amato and Assemblymen Brian E. Rumpf and Gregory E. Myhre called on BPU President Christine Guhl-Sadovy to reject the request.

"Certainly, the rate increase would represent a direct cost of living increase and would threaten the viability of many already struggling ratepayers to afford their current housing," they wrote. "When considering the ramifications for thousands of ratepayers who stand to have their natural gas bills spike sharply, it is clear that the Board has the responsibility to reject the unconscionable rate increase petition filed by New Jersey Natural Gas. Approving the rate increase would blatantly deviate from the Board's Mission Statement to ensure affordable rates to all members of the public who seek such services."

For its part, New Jersey Natural Gas said the increases are necessary in order to improve infrastructure and reliability for the future, according to president and CEO Steve Westhoven. The work includes replacing about 140 miles of lines and investing in cyber security.

"Our top priority is to safely and reliably deliver the energy our customers count on to heat their homes and run their businesses," Westhoven said in a written statement. "The investments we make in our infrastructure reflect this commitment and the critical role our system plays in reaching New Jersey's carbon reduction goals. We look forward to working with our regulators to achieve a successful resolution of this filing that is reasonable and fair for our customers and our company."

New Jersey Natural Gas serves about 576,000 customers in the state.

Lawmakers Call For Speedier ANCHOR Rebates

Many homeowners in Berkeley received a welcome envelope in the mail late last year: rebate checks from the state's ANCHOR program, the successor to the Homestead Rebate program.

But according to state lawmakers, not everyone has received their checks.

In 2023, \$2 billion was set aside in the state budget to fund the program. Under the plan, ANCHOR rebates of up to \$1,500 were sent to households making less than \$250,000 a year, and to renters making less than \$150,000 a year. Some 1.7 million residents in all were scheduled to receive the rebates, including many in Berkeley Township. Checks between \$450 and \$1,500 were expected to arrive by November 1.

However, state lawmakers representing the area said not everyone who is entitled to this benefit has received it.

"Discontentment among our constituents, especially for those who are still waiting for their ANCHOR benefit, is only growing as residents face the prospect of a tolls hike, costlier utility rates and property tax increases resulting from years of school funding cuts," State Senator Carmen Amato and Assemblymen Brian E. Rumpf and Gregory E. Myhre said in a letter to State Treasurer Maher Muoio. "Constituents rightfully ask why they have yet to receive their ANCHOR benefit."

Homeowners who have received a rebate in years past did not need to file for one. They are automatically enrolled.



Statewide, about 2 million qualifying residents who did not receive a rebate in years past should have gotten applications in the mail.

The Division of Taxation started mailing the letters last August. Checks were set to arrive by the end of the year. Payments are issued on a rolling basis, roughly 90 days after applying.

Anchor is the replacement for the Homestead Benefit. Homeowners with incomes up to \$150,000 are eligible to receive \$1,500, and those earning up to \$250,000 can receive \$1,000. Renters earning up to \$150,000 are eligible to receive \$450 to help offset rent hikes.

The program will again continue in 2024. Governor Phil Murphy has proposed \$3.5 billion in the coming state budget for tax relief, including the ANCHOR Program, Senior Freeze, and others.

"Our proposed budget will once again lower costs for middle- and working-class families — as well as seniors — by providing another round of historic tax relief," Murphy said in a press conference late last month. "So, at a time when families are grappling with higher prices at the checkout counter... we are putting more money back into their pockets than ever before."

However, Amato, Rumpf and Myhre said kinks in the program still need to be addressed.

"To the best of our ability, we have worked with your responsive staff to assist frustrated constituents with the process," the team said in their letter to Muoio. "However, it is becoming increasingly evident that corrective action is necessary to rectify the sluggish and seemingly random process by which ANCHOR benefits are issued."

Michael Hayes, assistant public policy professor at Rutgers University-Camden, said it's vital to get the word out about the program, because often, homeowners don't even know that programs like this exist.

"Sometimes these types of government programs are not fully utilized because people are not aware of them or in some cases there's high administrative burdens for people to complete the application to get their eligible benefit," he told WHYY.

27 More Acres Preserved Off Route 9; Plans Evolving for Old Mall Site

The Ocean County Board of Commissioners will help create another swath of green along Route 9 in Berkeley, thanks to the purchase of almost 27 acres there to be preserved as open space. The purchase was made at the end of last year.

The land is the former location of the Blackbeard's Cave amusement park. It will be added to the now more than 800 acres being preserved on and around the former New Jersey Pulverizing property, which extends from Route 9 to the Barnegat Branch Trail.

The county paid \$5.9 million to secure the property.

Mayor John Bacchione, then a councilman, said the preservation would mean long-term benefits for Berkeley residents.

"We are not only preserving open space, but we ultimately will provide additional recreational opportunities for our residents, protect the environment and maintain our quality of life," Bacchione said in a written statement.

The remnants of Blackbeard's Cave will be demolished and removed by the previous site owners at no cost to the township or county.

"This property along with an anticipated donation of 50 acres from the township expands our preserved open space in Berkeley Township substantially," said Ocean County Commissioner Virginia Haines. "When completed, residents and visitors will have access to some of the most beautiful areas of the township and it will forever remain open space."

Commissioner Joseph Vicari abstained on the vote. "I have some concerns as to the price that we are paying," Vicari said.

The purchase is just one part of a much larger effort to revitalize this portion of town. Just as notable, if not moreso, are the ongoing plans to rebuild the site of the former Beachwood Mall.



Last month, plans were unveiled for what might eventually be built on the site of the former mall, located in the Bayville section of Berkeley, just north of the Blackbeard's Cave site.

The site's redevelopers, M&M Realty Partners, has outlined a two-phase plan that would bring a supermarket, fast food chain, and a number of retail slots (potentially including a restaurant) to the site.

Previous plans called for a car wash, three restaurants (including fast food), and several larger retail outlets.

However, there are no specific chains or businesses that have been confirmed, nor have these plans been approved. They remain proposals that are constantly evolving.

The 40-acre site is in the Town Center Redevelopment Area, a specially designated area that now allows a wider variety of uses, including solar fields, warehouses, and recreation.

The Beachwood Mall long ago turned into an eyesore and was torn down. Town officials have been looking for a way to revitalize the property ever since.

Meanwhile, the nearby "WOBM Pit," located south on Rt. 9 behind Yesterday's, will be preserved rather than redeveloped. Last year, the county made the 46-acre former sand and gravel pit the latest addition to the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust's inventory of land.

Established in 1997, the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust was created to purchase and preserve environmentally sensitive lands, natural areas and open space for preservation against development. It collects funds through a 1.2-cent addition to the tax rate, and then directs those funds towards purchasing undeveloped land for the purposes of keeping that land undeveloped.

Generating about \$10 million annually, to date the Trust has protected over 25,000 acres of land in Ocean County.

Mayor & Council Pass Resolution Opposing March 2024 Toll Hike by NJ Turnpike Authority

At the last Township Council meeting, Mayor Bacchione and the Township Council approved a resolution opposing the March 2024 toll hike by the

New Jersey Turnpike Authority. The Turnpike Authority which operates both the Turnpike and Parkway, has instituted toll increases of 20% in September 2020, and 3% in both January 2022 and 2023. Now the Authority is requesting a 3% toll increase effective March 2024.

The proposed hike is untimely and unconscionable given the numerous rate hikes in recent years and the cost of inflation. This toll hike will greatly impact the residents of Berkeley Township and Ocean County at a time when most are already suffering a hardship due to the current economic climate.

Mayor & Council Apply for Grant for Bike Paths at Veterans Park

In addition, the Mayor and Council approved a resolution authorizing submission of a grant proposal of \$100,000 to the State Department of Community Affairs for the continuation of bike paths at Veterans Park. If awarded, this project would include recreational bikeways at Veterans Park. This bike path will provide residents and visitors with ample space to exercise, walk their dogs, and enjoy the outdoors. We are hopeful that the Township will be awarded monies from the State to fund this project.



How Seniors Can Spot (and Avoid) Colon Cancer

Colorectal cancer encompasses both colon cancer and rectal cancer. The condition is a leading cause of cancer-related deaths in the United States but with proper awareness and timely actions, it can be detected early and treated effectively.

Age is a significant risk factor for colon cancer, particularly for individuals over 50 years old. This makes awareness especially vital for senior citizens. Other risk factors include a family history of colon cancer or polyps, a personal history of inflammatory bowel disease (such as Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis), a diet high in red or processed meats, obesity, smoking, and heavy alcohol use.

Early stages of colon cancer may not present any symptoms, which is why regular colonoscopy screening is crucial. When symptoms do appear, they may include changes in bowel habits, including diarrhea or constipation; a feeling that your bowel does not empty completely; blood in your stool or very dark stools; constant tiredness or weakness; and unexplained weight loss.

"If you notice a change in your bowel habits, if you start seeing some blood in your stools, it's important that you contact your doctor, let them know and see if it's something significant," Dr. Paul Bierman, president of Gastrointestinal Specialists Foundation in Memphis, told Fox News.

While some factors like age and family history can't be changed, there are steps you can take to reduce your risk. They include maintaining a healthy diet rich in fruits, vegetables, and whole grains while limiting red and processed meats, staying physically active and maintain a healthy weight, and limiting alcohol consumption and smoking.

Also be sure to get regular screenings for colon cancer starting at age 50 or earlier if you have a family history of the disease.

The good news is that through screening, colon cancer can often be detected before symptoms develop, when it's most treatable. In fact, screening is essential because "if you get symptoms from a cancer in the colon, it usually means that it's quite advanced," Laura Valle, a cancer researcher at the Catalan Institute of Oncology, told Live Science magazine.

Screening can also find precancerous polyps, so they can be removed before they turn into cancer. Common screening options include:

- Colonoscopy: The most comprehensive screening method, allowing your doctor to view the entire colon and remove polyps during the procedure. It's recommended every 10 years starting at age 50 for those at average risk.
- Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT): A yearly test that checks for hidden blood in the stool, which can be an indicator of cancer.
- Sigmoidoscopy: Similar to a colonoscopy but examines only the lower part of the colon every 5 to 10 years.
- CT Colonography: A CT scan that allows doctors to look at the colon non-invasively, recommended every 5 years.

Each screening method has its advantages and recommendations may vary based on individual risk factors. Your healthcare provider can help you decide which method is best for you.

"It's estimated that more than half of colorectal cancer deaths could be prevented by early detection through screening -- and that's just not happening," UCLA cancer researcher Dr. Folasade May told U.S. News & World Report. "People need to start screening early and continue to have it done regularly throughout their lives."

Colon cancer remains a significant concern in the United States. Recent statistics show that each year, over 50,000 Americans die from the disease. However, rates of colon cancer have been decreasing among adults 50 and older due to increased awareness and screening.

Senior citizens who understand the risk factors, recognize the symptoms, practice preventive measures, and undergo regular screenings can significantly reduce your risk of this disease and be part of that decrease.


