## **County Proposes Trust Fund to Address Homelessness**

Getting a handle on how many people in Ocean County are homeless at any given moment is difficult. According to Monarch Housing Associates, at any given time, there are hundreds without a place to stay in the county, though the true number is difficult to determine. All told, some 19 percent of county households struggle with some form of housing insecurity, meaning they are at risk of losing their shelter – houses, apartments, and so on – at any moment.

Those people don't need just shelter, they need county services, healthcare, and more.

With this in mind, Ocean County is joining a dozen other counties in New Jersey in creating a Homelessness Trust Fund to improve the county's ability to help.

Under the plan, a \$5 surcharge will be applied to certain filings made with the Ocean County Clerk's Office. That surcharge will be directed to the fund, which will support programs aimed at the underprivileged.

"We can use the funds raised by the Homelessness Trust Fund with more flexibility to provide rental assistance vouchers, supportive services and prevention services," said Ocean County Commissioner Barbara Jo Crea, liaison to the Ocean County Department of Human Services.

The funds cannot be used to construct a homeless shelter.

Rather, they will be used for support services. This may include supporting housing rehabilitation and providing affordable housing within other residential construction projects.

The fee would go into effect September 1 of this year.

"The fund could raise anywhere from \$275,000 to \$390,000," Crea said. "These funds are raised annually and will be used to support ongoing homelessness and housing instability programs along with the Code Blue program."

The Code Blue program helps provide shelter to those in need during cold weather.

"This fund will complement the many traditional social services programs that are helping thousands of people living in Ocean County every day. A real benefit of the fund will be to serve individuals that were previously not eligible for services," she said.

A task force will be created to serve as an advisory board to help manage the program. The hope will be to provide stability to Ocean County families seeing difficult times.

"We are seeing increases in the under-employed and families are having a difficult time making ends meet and keeping a roof over their head," said Ocean County Commissioner Gary Quinn, who is also on the Ocean County Board of Social Services. "We need to do more and this is one of the tools we have available to us to create a permanent funding source that can be used to help our residents."

According to recent data, on any given night, approximately 553,000 Americans are homeless. This includes those living in shelters, transitional housing, or on the streets. Furthermore, a significant number of homeless individuals are suffering from chronic conditions or disabilities, making it even more challenging for them to escape the cycle of homelessness.

Many factors contribute to their situation, including rising housing costs, lack of affordable housing options, unemployment, mental health issues, and substance abuse.

Homelessness is not limited to urban areas; it affects communities across the country.

The measure was expected to be read at the July 6 meeting of the Ocean County Board of Commissioners. The public will have an opportunity to comment before final approval.

"There will be 20 days for public comment," Crea said. "We want to provide time for our residents to comment on this proposed action."

## NO MUNICIPAL TAX INCREASE IN 2023!

I am pleased to report the 2023 municipal budget was unanimously approved by the Township Council at a special meeting. As I stated last month, there is NO MUNICIPAL TAX INCREASE for 2023! The municipal budget will keep our tax rate the same as last year, at \$0.705 per \$100 of assessed valuation. This is extremely good news for our taxpayers. With the sharp increase due to inflation and the unique set of challenges due to the pandemic, this was no easy task to accomplish.

No municipal tax increase also means we will not have to send out estimated tax bills. This saves the township roughly \$30,000. We anticipate property owners will be receiving their FINAL third and fourth quarter tax bills mid-July. As customary, property owners will have until August 10th, to pay their August 1st (third quarter) property tax bill, without interest or penalties.

When you receive your tax bill, please keep in mind that the municipal portion, including our open space tax, is a little over 30% of the total bill. This is the ONLY portion of your tax bill under the direct control of the Mayor and Council. The remaining, nearly 70% of your bill, which includes county government, county library, county health, county open-space and the school district taxes, the Township has NO CONTROL over.

As mentioned last month, despite the challenges I mentioned above, Berkeley Township continues to have the 2nd lowest OVERALL property taxes in all of OCEAN COUNTY and 31st lowest OVERALL property taxes out of 564 municipalities in New Jersey.

Thank you to the members of the Township Council, especially Council President John Bacchione, who chairs our Finance Committee, for working with me to keep the costs of government down. The average Berkeley Township homeowner will continue to pay less than half of the statewide average property tax bill. That is a significant accomplishment we all can be proud of.

## MORE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF ON THE WAY IN 2024!

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for signing petitions, calling state legislators and the Governor's office, in support of our efforts for more property tax relief. If you recall, just a few short years ago, the State of New Jersey was considering CUTTING the Senior Freeze and Homestead Benefit property tax relief programs. What a difference a few years make. As you are aware, because of our combined efforts, the State of New Jersey - with bipartisan support - created a NEW Property Tax Relief program called the ANCHOR Program. (Affordable New Jersey Communities for Homeowners and Renters). The ANCHOR Program replaced the Homestead Property Tax Credit program. Under the ANCHOR Program, eligible homeowners received a check or direct deposit from the state treasury this past May, depending on your income levels. Homeowners who made \$150,000 or less in 2019, received \$1,500. Homeowners who made between \$150,001 and \$250,000, received a \$1,000. If you did not receive you ANCHOR payment, call the ANCHOR HOTLINE at: 1-888-238-1233.

Recently, the State of New Jersey - with bipartisan support - created a new property tax relief program called STAY-NJ. The STAY-NJ Program will provide seniors aged 65 and older, a 50% property tax reduction for senior homeowners earning \$500,000 or less, capped at \$6,500. This direct property tax relief program is slated to begin in January 2026. As part of the legislation, beginning next year in 2024, the ANCHOR Program will INCREASE by \$250. This means senior homeowners who made \$150,000 or less will receive \$1,750 and senior homeowners who made \$150,001 up to \$250,000, will receive \$1,250.

The Township Council, led by Council President John Bacchione, and I, unanimously supported and approved a resolution in support of the STAY-NJ Program. The State is becoming unaffordable for our seniors on fixed incomes. This program, when implemented, will provide additional and welcome property tax relief. I want to thank 9th District Assemblyman Brian Rumpf, a member of the state Assembly Budget Committee, who supported the program.

As Mayor, the Township Council and I will continue to keep a watchful eye on the State to make sure they uphold their commitment to fund these vital property tax relief programs for our residents.

## **Chicago Tribute Band Joins Summer Concert Series**

Those hoping to see Wanted DOA, a Bon Jovi tribute band, at Veterans Park this summer were met with bad news when the band announced they would have to cancel their July 19 show due to the death of their lead singer, Rich Figurido.

Thankfully for those who enjoy live music, Beginnings, a Chicago tribute act that has rocked stages for over 20 years, will be stepping in to fill their slot on the Summer Concert Series.

Wanted DOA issued a statement March 30 announcing Figurido's passing.

"He was an entertainer like no other and was put on earth to be on stage," the band wrote. "Needless to say that all that knew him are devastated by this loss. We ask that you remember him for his passion of music and performing. In the end he couldn't win his fight with cancer but he gave more to those around him then he will ever know."

In their place, Beginnings will bring Chicago's music to the stage, featuring a full seven-person lineup in tribute to Chicago's original, "classic" configuration. The band has toured throughout the United States.

"Being a musician and fan of Chicago for many years, as well as performing in bands that played Chicago material, I can say unequivocally that Beginnings is as close to the original band as you'll get," said Obie O'Brien, a Grammy Award-winning producer and engineer.

The rest of the Berkeley Summer Concert Series lineup remains thus far unchanged. Shows began on June 28 and will continue until Berkeley Pride Day, scheduled for September 9.

These events come at no cost to the taxpayer.

"As always, the cost of the summer entertainment is funded by community and business donations," Mayor Carmen Amato said.

All shows take place Wednesdays at Veterans Park, 489 Bill Zimmerman Jr. Way, unless otherwise noted. The shows will also be emceed by local radio station WJRZ.

Vocal group Rock N' Rhythm and the 1970s rock-inspired Super TransAm kicked off the series on June 28. Fireworks were also planned for July 4, shortly before this article went to print.

On July 19, local vocal group Jukebox Legends will sing classics from the 1950s and '60s before Beginnings takes the stage to play hits from throughout Chicago's career.



On Saturday, August 12, the series movies to White Sands Beach in South Seaside Park, where The Verdict will offer a beach vibe from 5 to 8pm with a mix of reggae and Caribbean music.

One of the bigger events will be August 23, with the Night Out Against Crime. That night will feature two headliners: Gerard Esposito, will do big show music from the Broadway and Las Vegas states, then Garden State Radio will play rock and pop hits from the 1980s to today.

The day will also serve as an opportunity for local emergency services to reach out to the community. Representatives from the Berkeley Township Police Department, along with local first aid and fire departments, and other public safety officials, will have interactive and educational displays, fundraising events, and more. Families will be able to see fire engines and other gear up close, there will be games and prizes, and other attractions.

The summer concert series will be capped off on September 9 for Berkeley Township Community Pride Day, which will also include a recognition of the 22nd anniversary of the September 11 attacks. The day begins at 2pm with vendors, fundraisers by an array of local nonprofits and community groups, food and handmade products, and more. At 5pm, there will be a ceremony honoring those last on 9/11.

The music begins at 6pm with Stiletto & the Saxman doing Rat Pack classics and popular standards from multiple generations. At 7:30pm, The Infernos Band will close out the Summer Concert Series with crowd favorites from four decades of music. Finally, there will be fireworks at 9pm.

Beyond mere entertainment, the concerts also provide a way for local civic and charitable groups to raise funds. Nonprofit groups are invited to set up stands to sell food at the shows. Serving as food vendors, the proceeds help benefit the organizations, which in turn benefits the community.

#### **Water Filtration**

#### When and Why Water Filtration May Be Needed

I have put multiple systems into my personal home. I have ripped out the ones I didn't like to try different ones that seem superior. I am literally on my third Reverse Osmosis (R.O.) The way I see it is if I am going to offer these products for our fantastic clients, I will only offer the ones I use for my family. Let's dive into the different types of water filtration and what their practical uses are.

The first type would be a cartridge filter that you replace periodically after they reach the end of their lifespan. You will know they are at the end because water pressure will drop and be noticeable. There are different types of cartridge filters. The most used are sediment filters and carbon cartridge filters. A sediment filter does exactly how it sounds. They remove sediment and small particles. These are typically installed first in a system. After the sediment filter you would install a carbon filter. This helps smell and taste by removing chlorine and smaller particles that didn't get removed by the sediment filter. You can also install either one by themselves depending on your filtration goals. I had a 20" sediment filter and a very large carbon cartridge filter, but I removed them because I got tired of replacing the cartridges every 6 months. This was the cheaper option but not the best solution. Due to my wife's dry hair and dry blotchy skin, I decided to remove those cartridge filters and install a citysoft water softener.

#### What is a water softener or a citysoft water softener?

Water softeners reduce water hardness by removing heavy minerals like calcium, iron, and magnesium, and prevent common water problems including mineral deposits and scale buildup leading to leaky faucets and clogged pipes, damage to appliances such as dishwashers, chalky films on cleaned glasses, dry skin and hair after showering, and faded cloths from the washing machine.

#### **Benefits of a water softener are:**

- Long term money savings
- Clean dishes and glasses better
- Hair is cleaner and skin will be Save time cleaning softer
- Clothes will be brighter and softer
- Makes drinking water clearer and better tasting

#### **Negatives of a water softener are:**

- Need to replenish salt every so often
- Need to backwash, which wastes a small amount of water
- Initial cost is expensive

**Citysoft** is used for city water, has both a carbon and softener in one. This system removes 90% of all contaminants in the water and solves most water issues in your home. The only thing that can remove the rest of the contaminants is an **R.O.** which we will touch on next time.

## Understanding Skin Cancer Risks in Your Senior Years By Eric San Tuan

As we age, it is essential to stay aware of our health and do what we can to prevent serious illnesses such as skin cancer. This is especially true during the summer months, when he lure of the golf course, boardwalk, and beach draws us outside.

According to the Skin Cancer Foundation, more than 9,500 Americans over the age of 65 are diagnosed with skin cancer every day. That's why it is important for retirees to understand the facts, including knowing the risk factors, recognizing signs and symptoms, being aware of potential complications, and learning about available treatment options.

Risk factors are anything that makes you more likely to develop a certain condition or disease. Common risk factors for skin cancer include: fair skin/light eyes, a family history of skin cancer, having frequent sun exposure (especially without adequate sun protection, like sunscreen), and using tanning beds. Avoiding these risk factors when possible can help reduce your chances of developing skin cancer.

Those with fair skin should get checked every year.

"If you have other risk factors, like you've got a strong family history of skin cancer, if you have a personal history of skin cancer, then sometimes that bumps up to every six months," dermatologist Dr. Chris Chu said.

There are several ways to reduce your risk. First, always wear sunscreen with SPF of at least 30 when spending time outside, especially during the summer. Additionally, try to limit your sun exposure and avoid tanning beds altogether. If you have risk factors such as a family history or fair skin, then it is especially important that you take these preventive measures.

It's also important to be aware of any signs or symptoms that may indicate the presence of skin cancer. Common warning signs include changes in the size, shape or color of a mole; new or changing moles; spots on the skin that are mottled, red or scaly; sores that won't heal; and any area of skin that is itchy or tender. If you have any suspicious looking spots on your skin, contact your doctor for further evaluation.



Melanoma, for example, is relatively easy to spot, if you know the signs, but can be deadly if not treated early.

"It's basically the pigment producing cell in the skin that goes bad and eventually it can grow large, but then it can also spread elsewhere into the body," onco-dermatologist Dr. Maxwell Sauder told CBC

If left untreated, skin cancer can spread to lymph nodes and other vital organs, leading to serious health issues and even death.

Thankfully, there are options available to treat skin cancer. They can include light surgery, chemotherapy, radiation therapy, or combination therapies, though in most cases, if caught early, cancerous growths can simply be trimmed away.

"When caught early, it's a very simple and straightforward treatment of cutting it out. It's when we let things progress, that's when the five-year overall survival rate goes lower so catching it early is almost infinitely curable," Sauder said.

Overall, while skin cancer is a serious disease that should not be taken lightly, it is important to remember that with early detection and proper treatment, most cases can be cured. Seniors should practice good sun safety habits, be aware of the signs and symptoms, and seek prompt medical care if they have any concerns about changes in their






