Veterans Health & Resources Fair Set for November 16 Also: County Opens Veterans Service Office in Whiting

Berkeley veterans – and there are many of them – will have an opportunity to get direct assistance accessing VA benefits, filing claims, and more during a Veterans Health & Resources Fair being held by the Ocean County Health Department (OCHD) on November 16.

The event will be held at the OCHD building at 175 Sunset Ave., Toms River from 4-7pm.

Veterans living in Ocean County will be able to received assistance with filing claims or death benefits, and information on transportation assistance. Staff will be on hand to help with mental health and substance abuse information, and to help with the Project Lifesaver Program.

There will also be access to seasonal vaccines, such as the flu shot, financial and legal assistance, screening for diabetes and other chronic diseases, and more.

Berkeley's vets will also have more access to nearby veterans services, now that a satellite office of the Ocean County Veterans Service Bureau has opened on Lacey Road in Whiting/Manchester.

A ribbon-cutting was held October 17 for the new facility, which is located at 82 Lacey Road. The building is home to Manchester Emergency Services, and is just down Route 530 from the Holiday City and Silver Ridge Park communities.

"Convenience is so important when it comes to accessing services that can help keep a roof over your head, food on your table, transportation, medical assistance, and so much more support that is available," said Ocean County Commissioner Gary Quinn. "Ocean County with almost 640 square miles can at times be tough to get around. We have been hard at work getting services directly to our residents and this satellite office will certainly help in our efforts to do that."

The office will be open from 10 am to 3 pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Veterans can make an appointment at 732-929-2096.

The new site joins the Ocean County Veterans Service Bureau main office at 1027 Hooper Ave., Building 2, Toms River. There is a second satellite office at the Ocean County Southern Service Center, 79 Main Street in Manahawkin.

The Health & Resources Fair and new Veterans Service Bureau satellite office join an array of other veterans services provided by the county.

For example, the Ocean Ride bus service provides free transportation for Ocean County veterans to area VA clinics. Trips are by reservation and must be scheduled in advance.

These free trips take veterans to the VA clinic in Brick Monday through Friday; East Orange Monday mornings and Thursday afternoons; Lyons on Tuesdays; Philadelphia on Wednesdays; and Marlton on Fridays.

For the Brick facility, call (732) 736-8989 and press 1 to schedule a pick-up up to four weeks in advance.

For the out of county facilities, call the Ocean County Veterans Service Bureau directly at (732) 929-2096. Please try to provide two weeks notice if possible.

According to the county, "Due to the long travel time to reach the various VA clinics, emphasis is placed on departures from centralized pick-up locations which are located conveniently throughout the County; including the Ocean County Administration Building, Southern Ocean County Hospital and others. Limited home pick-ups are available based on a case-by-case basis related to the mobility needs of the veteran."

In addition, the new Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) clinic in Toms River is expected to open in Spring of 2024.

The new clinic will be located at 1051 Hooper Avenue, right near Seacourt Pavilion in Toms River, and will be part of a larger complex that will include a new building for the Ocean County Board of Social Services and the county's own Veterans Service Bureau.

It will be a 68,000-square-foot facility with an outpatient clinic for veterans, parking for 480, and more. It's about twice the size of the Brick location and is expected to serve in excess of 12,000 patients a year, making it among the most active VA clinics in the state.

The clinic's services will include standard primary health care, as well as dental care, mental health counseling, physical therapy, and health services geared towards female veterans. It will be just one of 10 in the state, with the next closest in Tinton Falls.

Fulfill NJ Provides Food for Seniors in Need This Holiday Season

When the holidays come across, many turn their eyes towards those in need. For Fulfill NJ, however, the holidays are the same as any other time of year: a time to help ensure the hungry get fed.

Formerly known as the FoodBank of Monmouth & Ocean Counties, Fulfill is responsible for the mobile food pantry that visits the Holiday City/Silver Ridge Park communities each month. The organization also operates the B.E.A.T. Center at 1769 Hooper Ave., Toms River.

As of 2014, over 136,000 individuals in Ocean and Monmouth counties relied on the generosity of local food banks in order to eat, and that number rose sharply to 215,000 families since 2020. Many of them are senior citizens trying to stretch a very limited income.

Overall, 1 in 10 people in the area have received some sort of emergency food from soup kitchens, food pantries, and other charitable organizations. Each month in Berkeley, between 70 to 100 people visit the mobile food pantry to ensure they have enough to eat for the month ahead.

"We now serve enough food for 1 million meals each month," said Fulfill CEO and President Triada Stampas.

The mobile food pantry serves the Holiday City / Silver Ridge Park area the fourth Friday of every month from 10am to 11am. It set up outside of Clubhouse 2 of Holiday City, 631 Jamaica Blvd.

A second distribution site is located at 44 Frederick Drive, Bayville, in front of the Housing Office, where it sets up every fourth Thursday of the month from 10am to 10:45am.

The visit provides direct access to free food for Berkeley retirees who can use the help. This includes fresh fruits, vegetables, canned goods and more, most of it donated by grocery stores and residents throughout the area.

Applicants must meet certain income requirements to qualify for assistance. Applications can also be filled out on-site on distribution days. Volunteers are on-hand to help people through the process.

The food comes from donations, both from individual as well as from corporate partners. This includes local grocery stores.

"Every one of our partners means the world to us. Most importantly, we have a strong network of 300 feeding partners that ensure we are reaching thousands of our neighbors every week," Stampas said. "We could not fulfill our mission at the Jersey Shore without our partners' contributions."

In addition to the two Berkeley locations, other mobile food pantry stops include in Lakehurst at 204 Elm St. on the first Tuesday of the month from 9:30am to 10:30am; 3204 Hilltop Road in Manchester on the first Tuesday of the month from 11:30am to 12:30pm; and in

Toms River at 923 Oak Avenue on the fourth Wednesday of the month from 12:30pm-1:30pm.

But they can't do it alone. They need your help, either through volunteering or direct donations. Almost everything they do and give to the community – upwards of 87 percent of all operations - comes via donations.

GERD or Acid Reflux

Lots of people suffer with GERD. Mine started in my 50s. I thought it was too many Margaritas at my favorite Mexican place. Drinking them earlier in the night and cutting down on the numbers didn't help.

GERD is a chronic condition caused by changes in the gastroesophageal valve that allows stomach acid to flow back up into your esophagus. GERD can result in both bothersome or painful symptoms. Common symptoms include: Heartburn, Chest Pain, Regurgitation, Trouble Swallowing and Food Sensitivity

If left untreated, reflux can lead to serious conditions including Barrett's esophagus or, in fewer cases, esophageal cancer. When reflux extends beyond the lower esophagus, it can lead to trouble sleeping, sore throat and persistent cough, as well as gas and bloating. These symptoms can indicate a condition called laryngopharyngeal reflux (LPR).

What is a Hiatal Hernia? Many people with GERD also have a hiatal hernia, which happens when part of the stomach moves up into the chest cavity. A hiatal hernia can make acid reflux worse if the hiatus (the hole in the diaphragm that allows food and liquids to pass into the stomach) is enlarged and allows stomach acid to flow back into the esophagus.

Your doctor can help you decide on medication, a procedure or the easy one which could be new eating habits. The last one worked pretty well for me.

Managing the Effects of COPD as a Senior Citizen

November is COPD Awareness Month, making this a good time to brush up on chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, or COPD.

Heard the term aren't sure what it is?

COPD is a serious and progressive lung disease that affects millions of people worldwide. It is often seen in older adults, with the majority of cases being diagnosed in individuals over the age of 65. This ailment makes it difficult to breathe. It includes two main conditions: emphysema and chronic bronchitis.

In emphysema, the air sacs in the lungs are damaged, causing them to lose their elasticity and making it difficult for the lungs to expand and contract. Meanwhile, chronic bronchitis is characterized by inflammation and narrowing of the airways, also making breathing difficult.

"On average, individuals diagnosed with COPD typically have a reduced life expectancy compared to those without the disease," Robert Goldberg, M.D., a pulmonologist in Mission Viejo, CA told HealthLine. He said life expectancy can be reduced by up to six years.

This condition is more widespread than you may realize. In fact, according to the World Health Organization (WHO), an estimated 251 million people globally suffer from COPD. In the United States alone, over 16 million adults have been diagnosed with COPD, and it is believed that millions of others have undiagnosed or misdiagnosed cases.

The most common symptoms include shortness of breath, wheezing, chest tightness, and chronic coughing. These symptoms can greatly impact a person's quality of life, making simple tasks like walking or climbing stairs difficult. Symptoms are most likely to arise when you are active, such as during physical activities.

The primary risk factor for developing COPD is smoking, with about 90% of cases being linked to cigarette smoke.

"When you breathe in cigarette smoke, what happens is that goes into your lungs, that causes inflammation. Over time, that inflammation causes damage to your lung tissue," Dr. Audreesh Banerjee, co-director of the COPD program at Penn Medicine, told ABC News.

However, other factors, such as exposure to air pollution and occupational hazards like chemicals and dust can also increase the risk. Genetics may also play a role in developing COPD, with some individuals being more susceptible than others, though that is still being studied.

COPD is a progressive disease, meaning it worsens over time. It can lead to complications such as respiratory infections, heart problems, and even lung cancer. In fact, COPD is among the leading causes of death in the United States. Additionally, individuals with COPD are at a higher risk of developing depression and anxiety due to the impact on their daily lives.

A 2022 study in Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report showed that the highest mortality rates included those who worked in the mining industry and those with a background in the food preparation/service industry.

"The elevated COPD mortality among ever-employed persons in certain industries and occupations underscores the importance of targeted interventions to prevent COPD from developing and intervening before it becomes symptomatic or severe," wrote the authors.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), more than half of individuals aged 65 years or older have some form of COPD. As we age, our lung function naturally decreases, making it crucial for older Americans to manage their lung health.

One of the most important steps for managing COPD is to quit smoking if you are a smoker. This can slow down the progression of the disease and improve lung function. Maintaining a healthy lifestyle with regular exercise and a nutritious diet can also improve overall health and lung function. For example, aerobic exercises like walking or swimming can help strengthen the muscles used for breathing and improve shortness of breath.

It is also important for senior citizens with COPD to stay up to date on vaccinations, especially for respiratory infections like pneumonia and influenza, aka the flu. These infections can be dangerous for individuals with COPD and may lead to hospitalization or even death. It is also crucial to regularly monitor your symptoms and seek proper medical treatment as needed. This may include medications, pulmonary rehabilitation, and oxygen therapy.

"Its detrimental effects on life expectancy cannot be overstated," Dr. Goldberg said. "Continued smoking worsens COPD symptoms, accelerates the decline in lung function, and increases the risk of complications and mortality."

COPD is treated differently for each individual, as it depends on the severity of the disease and other health factors. However, some common treatments include bronchodilators to help open up airways, steroids to reduce inflammation in the lungs, and antibiotics if there is an infection present.

Pulmonary rehabilitation is also a recommended treatment for COPD. This program involves exercise training, education on managing the disease, and counseling to help cope with the emotional aspects of living with the ailment.

In severe cases, oxygen therapy may be necessary. This involves using a portable device or mask to deliver oxygen directly to the lungs, improving breathing and overall oxygen levels in the body. These devices can greatly improve quality of life for seniors with severe COPD.

COPD is a serious condition. By being proactive and seeking proper treatment, senior citizens with COPD can maintain a good quality of life and minimize the risks associated with the disease.




